



CACHE Advanced Diploma in Childcare and Education Online

The Council for Awards in Children's Care and Education (CACHE) is the largest qualifying authority for childcare qualifications in the United Kingdom. It deals solely with childcare qualifications and runs Level 1, 2, 3 and 4 courses throughout Britain and the world.

Duration: 2 years part-time

Fee: £330 per module - £1980 total – this may be paid in 6 instalments

Entry Requirements:

- Preferably a Level 3 qualification in Childcare and Education although if you have several years' experience of working with children this may be sufficient.
- Access to Internet and word processing facilities are essential.
- You must be working (paid or voluntary) with children for about 18 hours per week while you study the course.
- You will be asked to write a short piece when applying so we can judge your standard in English.

Course content:

This is an academic course, which is assessed by assignment at the end of each module. It gives students 120 CATS points towards university entrance. The dissertation is an original research project, which will be 7500 words long; therefore you must be competent in writing in English.

There are six modules and these will be chosen from the following, which are currently available. The dissertation module is compulsory.

- Observation and Assessment
- Disability and Special Educational Needs
- Management in Childcare Settings
- Early Years Curriculum
- Language and Literacy
- Feelings and Relationships
- Dissertation
