

CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Children's Care, Learning and Development – Online

The Council for Awards in Children's Care and Education (CACHE) is the largest qualifying authority for childcare qualifications in the United Kingdom. It deals solely with childcare qualifications and runs Level 1, 2, 3 and 4 courses throughout Britain and the world.

Duration: 1 year part-time

Fee: £1365 – payable in two instalments

Entry Requirements:

- Candidates should be already working in childcare environments with children between the ages of 0-16.
- Candidates should be seeking to gain further knowledge and skills to enhance their practice.
- Candidates should possess the equivalent of all the key skills at Level 2 and be competent in word processing skills and internet searches.

Course Content:

There are 5 units each assessed separately.

- Unit 1 - Principles and values underpinning work with children and the protection and promotion of children's rights.
- Unit 2 - The provision of healthy, safe and secure environments for children.
- Unit 3 - The provision of effective, high quality childcare environments.
- Unit 4 - Promoting child and young person development.
- Unit 5 - Promoting learning within early education frameworks.

Course assessment:

Four units are assessed through assignment tasks marked by the College tutor.

Unit 2 is assessed by a one hour multiple choice test paper, set and externally marked by CACHE.
