

CACHE Certificate for Teaching Assistants – Level 3 – Online

The Council for Awards in Children's Care and Education (CACHE) is the largest qualifying authority for childcare qualifications in the United Kingdom. It deals solely with childcare qualifications and runs Level 1, 2, 3 and 4 courses throughout Britain and the world.

The term 'Teaching Assistant' embraces the roles of classroom assistants, learning support assistants and special needs assistants.

Duration: 1 year part-time

Fee: £575

Entry Requirements:

- Candidates should be 18 years old or above and should have already studied to Level 2 and have attained qualifications at that level.
- Candidates should be working in a school (paid or voluntary) at Foundation Stage or Key Stage 1 (3 to 7 years old) for at least 60 hours per unit.
- Candidates should preferably have previous experience of working with children and should be familiar with the UK National Curriculum and The Foundation Stage Guidance.
- You will need to provide a Personal Profile

Course Content:

There are 2 units incorporating 15 topics.

- Unit 1 The Role of the Teaching Assistant in the School
- Unit 2 Supporting Pupils with Particular Learning Needs

Assessment:

Each unit is assessed by written assignments of 3500 words.

Unit 1 is marked externally by CACHE and Unit 2 is marked within the college.
