International Diploma in Health Care (IVQ)

This qualification is the first of its kind for delivery in India by educational institutions/hospitals.

The aims of the IVQ qualifications are to:

- support the learning needs of individuals who work or aim to work as care workers in the health care sector
- allow individuals to learn, develop and practice the skills required for employment and/or career progression in the health and care sector

Based upon the agreed UK national occupational standards these qualifications can be used by learners in their own country and may act as a progression route for applying to the College in UK to complete NVQ Level 2/3.

The qualification consists of four units. For each unit the student needs to pass an assignment.

Qualification can be obtained on a 6 month programme. Per week commitment involves study for 4 hrs and 15 hrs work placement for practical experience. This is arranged in a hospital.

Entry requirements:

The candidate will need to have completed HSC/ICSE/CBSE, with Science stream, English and be at least 18 years of age.
