This is a practical Level 3 course for students with a real enthusiasm for art and design who are seeking a career in this growing and exciting industry. This course is ideal if you wish to experience a wide range of art and design disciplines before specialising in a subject pathway.

What courses can I do after this?

Upon successful completion of the course most students progress on to higher education (degree or HND in their chosen area of study). On completing the course you will have gained the equivalent of 3 A levels along with a substantial portfolio of art work that demonstrates your practical skills in a specialist subject area. This will assist you with interviews at university or if applying for work in the creative industries

You will require a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grades A*-C including English and maths grades 9-4 (formerly A*-C).
