[Bournemouth & Poole College](#) has been awarded third place in the national [Whatuni](#) Student Choice Awards (WUSCA) for the [Further Education College category](#).

The WUSCAs take place every year to get an overview of student satisfaction in higher education across the UK. For the first time this year, three new categories were added to the awards line-up including the Further Education College award.

More than 36,000 students from across Britain took part in this year's survey, breaking all previous records.
