Bournemouth & Poole College has exceeded the national average in a student survey which invites them to rate the staff, courses and support.

The [National Student Survey](#) received an unprecedented response rate from students at the Bournemouth & Poole College who provided their feedback on their lecturers and the many aspects of their experience of studying level four courses and above.

In total, 84-per-cent of Bournemouth & Poole College students responded to the survey, which is above the national average for the sector of 72-per-cent, and it is a four-per-cent increase on the 2018 figures. Of the students who responded, 86-per-cent said that they were satisfied with their chosen course, which was above the national average of 81-per-cent.

Meanwhile, over 90-per-cent of students said that the College's lecturers and tutors are good at explaining their course content and are available to offer support when needed. Students also agreed that their courses were intellectually stimulating and had challenged them to achieve their best work.
