There will also be opportunities to find out about apprenticeships with local businesses that are starting in early 2018.

A recent report from the Workers' Educational Association (WEA) also showed the positive impact that offering a person the chance to return to learning has, indicating that 57 per cent of adults surveyed now feel better equipped to find work and 82 per cent report improvements in mental health and wellbeing.
