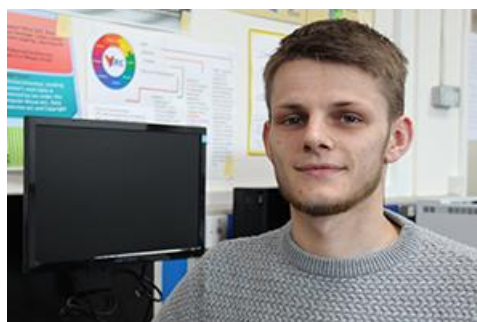
## Sam Davidge, FdSc Business Computing
