The Bournemouth & Poole College has launched a new worldwide distributor training partnership with <u>Sunseeker International</u>, drawing global attention to Poole. From December 2016 onwards, the College will host an annual four day technical training course which is open to all Sunseeker International distributor service technicians.

More than 36 Sunseeker technicians from all over the world, including Asia, Finland and Spain enrolled onto the first four day technical training course held at The Bournemouth & Poole College's North Road site.

The College already has an established relationship with Sunseeker International since the opening of its Marine Technology Centre in 2012. Earlier this year as part of Sunseeker's long term talent strategy, 40 marine apprentices were employed by the manufacturer, bringing the current total apprentices to more than 90.

Most importantly it gives me the opportunity to meet all the other service technicians from around the world, giving us a chance to share ideas, problems and solutions."
