In brief...

This course is designed to provide you with a good knowledge of barbering and general hairdressing to enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. Level 2 is the minimum required by the industry to work as a barber, so is an industry requirement starting point. You will study GCSE English and/or Maths (if applicable) and work experience as part of your study program.

Who is it for?

The course is designed to provide you with a good working knowledge of Barbering. It will enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. During the programme you will be required to take part in work experience in a local salon/barbers, it could suit those who have completed Level 1 or 2 Ladies Hairdressing who wish to go into the barbering industry

What courses can I do after this?

This is a good course for those wishing to go straight into employment in the industry as a Junior Barber However you can progress onto the Level 2 Diploma in Ladies Hairdressing . You will be advised which is most suitable for you.

What jobs can I get?

Employment as a Junior position at a Barber

What do I need to apply

To do this course you should have...

A minimum of 4 GCSEs at grades 9-3 (formerly A\* - D) including English and Maths or Level 1/2 Hairdressing qualification and have achieved a Level 1 Functional Skill in English and Maths.

What about work experience?

You will complete a minimum of 45-60 days of work experience in a local salon/Barbers

## Underpinning knowledge

As part of your timetable you will be required to work one evening a week in one of The College's Salons, Flaunt Hair, as part of getting you work-ready.
