The Level 3 Diploma in Warehousing and Storage has been developed in collaboration with the Sector Skills Body in response to emerging industry trends and the skills and knowledge requirements of employers. By achieving this nationally recognised qualification you will gain a valuable understanding of warehousing and logistics in a supervisory or team leader position to the level of professionalism required by this sector.

Who is it for?

This qualification gives the learner the opportunity to develop their specific knowledge and competency in warehouse management, topics include: customer care in logistics operations; leadership for your team; supervision of receipt; storage and dispatch of goods; and health, safety and security for the team.
