



The Course

In brief...

This course is designed for people with an ambition for a career in the Hair & Beauty industry. It will provide you with a good introduction from which you could progress to further courses.

During the course you will be introduced to practical expertise and some knowledge of the industry. You will receive help and support with your academic skills to help you progress onto further courses.

Please be aware that as part of your practical lessons students learn the treatments on each other. Further development is then performed on paying clients.

**Who is it for?**

This course is designed for those who have a passion for Hair & Beauty and want to learn basic treatments before progressing onto Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Therapy or Hair Level 2.

What the Course Leads to

**What courses can I do after this?**

Progression to suitable qualifications such as the Level 2 Diploma/Certificate in Beauty Studies, Level 2 Diploma in Hairdressing or Level 2 Diploma in Hair and Media Make-up or Apprenticeship training.

**What jobs can I get?**

Job opportunities could include working as a junior Beauty Therapist or trainee hair stylist in a salon. This course can enable you to progress onto further Hair or Beauty Therapy courses here at the College.

What do I need to apply

**To do this course you should have...**

You will need to achieve 4 GCSEs grades including English and maths grades 3-1 (formerly D-G). Alternatively successful completion of a Foundation Entry Level 3 qualification and have achieved an Entry Level 3 Functional Skill in English and maths. Each applicant will be assessed on their individual merits, and a keen interest & self motivation in Hair and Beauty as a career is essential. You will also be invited to a skills day as part of your interview for this program, to ascertain your dexterity skills on a given task.

**What about work experience?**

Each learner will be expected to work within our Flaunt salons and dispensary area, to gain valuable Customer care skills. All students will also complete a voluntary industry workplacement in an external local salon for a minimum of 1 week, which you will need to organise yourself.
