### In brief...

This course is designed to provide you with a good knowledge of barbering and general hairdressing to enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. Level 3 will enable you to practise independently or rent-a-chair in an existing salon/barbers. You will study GCSE English and/or Maths (if applicable) and work experience as part of your study program.

### Who is it for?

The course is designed to provide you with indepth working knowledge of Barbering. It will enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. During the programme you will be required to take part in work experience in a local salon/barbers, it could suit those who have completed Level 2 Ladies Hairdressing or L2 in Barbering

This is a good course for those wishing to go straight into employment in the industry as a Barber. Alternatively you could progress and develop your skills in Womens Hairdressing at L2.

### To do this course you should have...

You will have needed to complete a Level 2 hair qualification, preferably in Barbering (but work experience will be considered if in Women's hairdressing) A minimum of 4 GCSEs at grades 9-4 (formerly A\* - D) including English and Maths and have achieved a Level 1 Functional Skill in English and Maths.

### What about work experience?

You will complete a minimum of 45-60 days of work experience in a local salon/Barbers

### Underpinning knowledge

As part of your timetable you will be required to work one evening a week in one of The College's Salons, Flaunt Hair, as part of getting you work-ready.
