



The Course

In brief...

This well-recognised qualification is equivalent to 3 A Levels for the two year Extended Diploma. It is suitable if you have an interest in Business and Management and would welcome the opportunity to study a broad-based, vocational programme, before progressing to university.

Who is it for?

Students who aspire to go onto University or Higher Level Apprenticeships. It is also suitable for students who want to learn about different business-related careers or start their own business.

What the Course Leads to

What courses can I do after this?

You could progress to higher education for a degree or HND or to employment in marketing, finance or administration for example. There are also opportunities for students to progress to apprenticeships in a relevant business sector.

What jobs can I get?

The Bournemouth & Poole College is affiliated with many professional bodies in the area of Business, Finance and Administration. The skills and knowledge you will develop on this course are designed to meet the current demands of industry and commerce, and you will find that many of the skills are transferable and will have currency in a wide range of careers from retail to finance, marketing, events management, sales and customer service roles.

What do I need to apply

To do this course you should have...

We require a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grades 9 - 5 (formerly A* - C) including English and mathematics.

What about work experience?

You will participate in a work experience placement that is relevant to your studies as part of this course. The College will support and help find placement employers but you are encouraged to seek your own placement employer.

International entry requirements

If you are not from an English Language speaking country, you will need to have UKVI IELTS 5.5. We accept a wide range of academic qualifications awarded overseas and use the UK NARIC (National Academic Recognition Information Centre) guidelines for international comparisons.
