You will require a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grades 9-5 including English and maths grades 9-5 (formerly A*-C). Alternatively successful completion of a relevant Level 2 qualification and have achieved a Level 2 Functional Skill in English and maths.

What about work experience?

A minimum of 30 hours work experience is included in the study programme.

If you are not from an English Language speaking country, you will need to have UKVI IELTS 5.5.
