Important Update: Returning to College in September

Although the Government have continued to implement its COVID-19 roadmap, we all have a part to play and our individual actions continue to be extremely important in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Whether you are joining us for the first time in September, or continuing your studies with us for another year, it is important that you are aware of The College's rules and suggestions to keep students and staff as safe as possible.

Testing

It is important that you continue to take your COVID-19 home tests. Please ensure that they are completed the day before you are due to begin/return to college, and log your results on the NHS and College websites. More information on testing can be found at thecollege.co.uk/testing

Conduct

Despite the Government's continued relaxation of COVID-19 related restrictions, we recognise the importance of continuing aspects of the guidelines to ensure the College and wider community are safe for everyone.

Face Coverings

Please wear face coverings in all shared areas and corridors in college. Exempt students should discuss their needs with The College where appropriate.

Hand Sanitiser

Please continue to practice good hygiene. Hand sanitiser will be placed at all entrances and you must use it when you enter a building.

'Bubbles'

If you are aged 16-18, you may have become used to being placed in a "bubble"; this is no longer required by the Government and so we will not be setting up bubbles this year. However, we would encourage you to be sensible about social distancing at all times when you are in and around the College and try as far as you can, to minimise the risk of transmission.

Social Spaces

When you are not in lessons you must not congregate in corridors and in particular, the practice of sitting on floors in the corridor is not permitted. There are a variety of spaces available for you to use when you are not in lessons and these will be open as normal this year. Classrooms doors will be open when sessions are not taking place except where there are security or other reasons for them to be locked and you should feel free to access your normal classroom outside of formal sessions if it is both vacant and open. However, you may not use classrooms to consume hot food.

Our smoking shelters will be in use and it will be the responsibility of users to maintain a safe distance from each other.
