In brief...

This course is designed to provide you with a good knowledge of barbering to enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. Level 3 will enable you to practise independently or rent-a-chair in an existing salon/barbers. You will study GCSE English and/or Maths (if applicable) and work experience as part of your study program.

Who is it for?

The course is designed to provide you with indepth working knowledge of Barbering. It will enable you to develop a strong awareness of the industry. During the programme you will be required to take part in work experience in a local salon/barbers, it could suit those who have completed Level 2 Ladies Hairdressing or L2 in Barbering

What the Course Leads to

What courses can I do after this?

This is a good course for those wishing to go straight into employment in the industry as a Barber. Alternatively you could progress and develop your skills in Womens Hairdressing at L2.

What jobs can I get?

Employment as a position at a Barber

What do I need to apply

To do this course you should have...

You will have needed to complete a Level 2 hair qualification, preferably in Barbering (but work experience will be considered if in Women's hairdressing) A minimum of 5 GCSEs at grades 9-4 (formerly A* - D) including English and Maths or have achieved a Level 2 Functional Skill in English and Maths. You will also need to bring in your own suitable models to be assessed on.

What about work experience?

You will complete a minimum of 45-60 days of work experience in a local salon/Barbers

Underpinning knowledge

As part of your timetable you will be required to work one evening a week in one of The College's Salons, Flaunt Hair, as part of getting you work-ready. You will study Functional Skills in English or/and mathematics or GCSE in English and/or Maths. The course is designed to provide you with a good working knowledge of Barbering.
