Here's a few guidelines to help you prepare to study plastering.

I hope you will enjoy getting organised for your new start at College. For plastering theory lessons you will need:

 A pen, as all other items, i.e. rulers, calculators etc will be provided. We recommend buying a box as you will lose, forget, misplace or break them during the course of the year For the practical side you will need:

- 1. A pair of steel toe capped boots
- 2. A change of clothes (designer clothes will only get ruined)
- 3. A small steel padlock for your personal locker
